

## PROCESS SAFETY MANAGEMENT COMPLIANCE TIMELINE

The revised and updated Cal/OSHA Process Safety Management (PSM) standard requirements aim to reduce the risk of incidents by minimizing process safety hazards in petroleum refineries. Companies operating in California have choices to make regarding how to comply with the updated PSM standard. Refiners can either meet the minimal requirements over a 5-year period, or they can decide how to invest in more efficient and compliant processes that continually improve facility management and performance. ABS Group recommends a risk based approach to promote safer, more reliable operations through a proactive HSE culture and process safety leadership.
